

Homemade Playdough

Materials List:

4. **Colorful Fun!:** Remove the dough from the pan and let it cool for a minute. Divide the dough into portions and add a few drops of food coloring to each. Knead the dough with your hands until the color is mixed in evenly. (Tip: wear gloves if you don't want your hands to get colorful!)
5. **Time to Play!:** Your playdough is ready to mold and shape! Use cookie cutters, a rolling pin, or just your hands to create whatever your imagination dreams up—animals, shapes, or even tiny sculptures!
6. **Store for Later:** When playtime is over, store your playdough in an airtight container to keep it soft and squishy for future fun.
