

Personalized Mugs

6. **Bake Your Mug:** Preheat the oven to **350°F (180°C)**. Once the mug is dry, place it in the oven on a baking sheet and bake for **30 minutes**. This step seals the paint, making it dishwasher-safe. Let the mug cool down inside the oven when it's done. (Be sure to ask for help from a grown-up!)
7. **Enjoy Your Masterpiece:** Once it's fully cool, your mug is ready for use! Now you can sip your favorite drink from a mug you designed yourself!
