

Tissue Paper Flowers

3. **Tie the Center:** Once you've folded the tissue paper into a fan, twist a pipe cleaner or floral wire around the center of the folded paper. This will become the stem of your flower!
4. **Trim the Edges:** Use scissors to trim the ends of the folded paper into a rounded or pointed shape. This will give your petals a softer or spikier look when you fluff them out.
5. **Fluff the Petals:** Gently separate each layer of tissue paper, pulling it upwards toward the center. Keep fluffing until you have a full, round flower. Be gentle, as tissue paper can tear easily.
6. **Shape the Stem:** Twist the remaining pipe cleaner or floral wire into a neat stem. If you want a leaf, you can shape a small loop in the pipe cleaner.
7. **Optional Flower Center:** Glue a button or pom-pom to the center of your flower for a cute finishing touch. Let it dry before moving on to the next step.
8. **Make a Bouquet:** Repeat the process to make more flowers in different colors, then gather them together to create a colorful bouquet!

Craft Bonus: Add Some Flair!

- **Scented Flowers:** Add a drop of essential oil to each flower for a lovely, scented bouquet!
- **Rainbow Flowers:** Use all the colors of the rainbow in one flower for a bright and happy bloom.
- **Make a Flower Crown:** Attach your tissue paper flowers to a headband or crown base for a festive accessory!
